- **RID and DHHS Continuing Education Activity Instructor's Form**

The following definitions will be used for ASR workshops and participant classifications:

BEGINNER - ASL 1 and 2 students, students with little or no prior knowledge of ASL/Deaf Culture

INTERMEDIATE - ASL 2 and 3 students, those with basic understanding of simple concepts in ASL and able to have introductory conversations.

ADVANCED - ASL 3 & 4 students, those fairly conversational in ASL.

INTERPRETERS - Working and /or certified interpreters, those comfortably fluent in ASL
